





Effective CSHE

- Sexual health education
- Broader concept of sexuality, not just biology
- A person's sexual health includes their physical, mental, emotional and social well-being in relation to their sexuality





What works?

Focus on relationships, communication & boundaries

Evidencebased information Teacher modelling and student practicing of skills & boundaries

Adequate time

Sexual health is taught as part of overall health

Safe & inclusive practice

Confident, non-judgmental, and comfortable teachers





What do students want?






Are students having sex? Safer sex? When and how?




Sexual Activity

Sexual Activity of 12 to 18 Year-Olds






Alberta Reportable STI Rates, Teens

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Parent Notification

Notifying Parents

Schools to provide parents with notice where courses of study, educational programs or instructional materials, or instruction or exercises, include subject matter that deals **primarily and explicitly with religion or human sexuality**.

Where a parent makes a **written request**, a student shall be exempt, without academic penalty, from such instruction, course of study, educational program or use of instructional material.

Education Act

Welcoming, Caring, Respectful and Safe Learning Environments

Students are entitled to welcoming, caring, respectful and safe learning environments that respect diversity and nurture a sense of belonging and a positive sense of self.




