
Circumcised Penis

Menstrual Cycle




Note that this diagram shows a menstrual cycle of 28 days, which is an average. Cycles can vary between 24-38 days long.











First Trimester First Baby called an embryo. Month Is about 6 mm long. Second Arm and leg buds are Month starting to show. Is about 2.5 cm long. Third Baby called a fetus. 2 Months Month Eyes, ears, nose and mouth are formed.

Second Trimester Fourth Fetus has fingernails Month and toenails. Can hear sounds. Fifth Fetus will kick, twist Month and turn in uterus. Is about 25 cm long. Sixth Fetus can hiccup, and Month open and close eyelids. 6 Months Weighs about 1 kg.
