Teaching Sexual Health

Let's explore three important topics related to sexual health:

- Birth control
- STBBIs (sexually transmitted and blood-borne infections)
- Abstinence

You'll be exploring these topics using a tool called a Frayer model.

What is a Frayer model?

A Frayer model is a chart that helps you break down and understand an idea by looking at it in four different ways. You'll complete one Frayer model for each of the three topics: birth control, STBBIs and abstinence.

Each Frayer model has these four sections:

- **Definition:**
What does this term mean? Write a clear explanation in your own words.
- **Characteristics:**
What are the key facts or features of this topic? Think about how it works, who can use it, and what its purpose is.
- **Examples:**
What are some specific types or examples of this topic? Try to name at least two or three.
- **Non-examples:**
What are things that **do not** fit this topic? Try to name at least two or three.







