### Learning Outcome

Now Peyton is not sure they did the right thing because Jordan wants to have sex all the time. Jordan never wants to hang out with friends anymore but instead tells Peyton to come over to the apartment. Peyton knows Jordan expects sex whenever they are together.

Peyton is afraid to talk to anyone about this because Peyton's family and friends have never really liked Jordan. Peyton lies to their parent and says they are going out with friends when they are really going to Jordan's place. Peyton loves Jordan and doesn't want to hear people say negative things.
