W-9.12 determine “safer” sex practices, e.g., communicate with partner, maintain abstinence, limit partners, access/use condoms/contraceptives properly




Consent

Consent means agreeing to something. Consent is given freely. Consent is ongoing, which means you have to keep checking in, in case something changes. Consent can be withdrawn at any time. This means you can change your mind, even if you have already said yes. When there's consent, both people feel safe and comfortable. Consent can lead to better relationships and communication with family, friends and romantic partners.


1. Think of two examples in your life where you have asked for consent, or when someone has asked for your consent. Write them here:




A little later...






Write your own comic that shows a conversation where consent is not present.



Sometime later...






Reflection Questions
